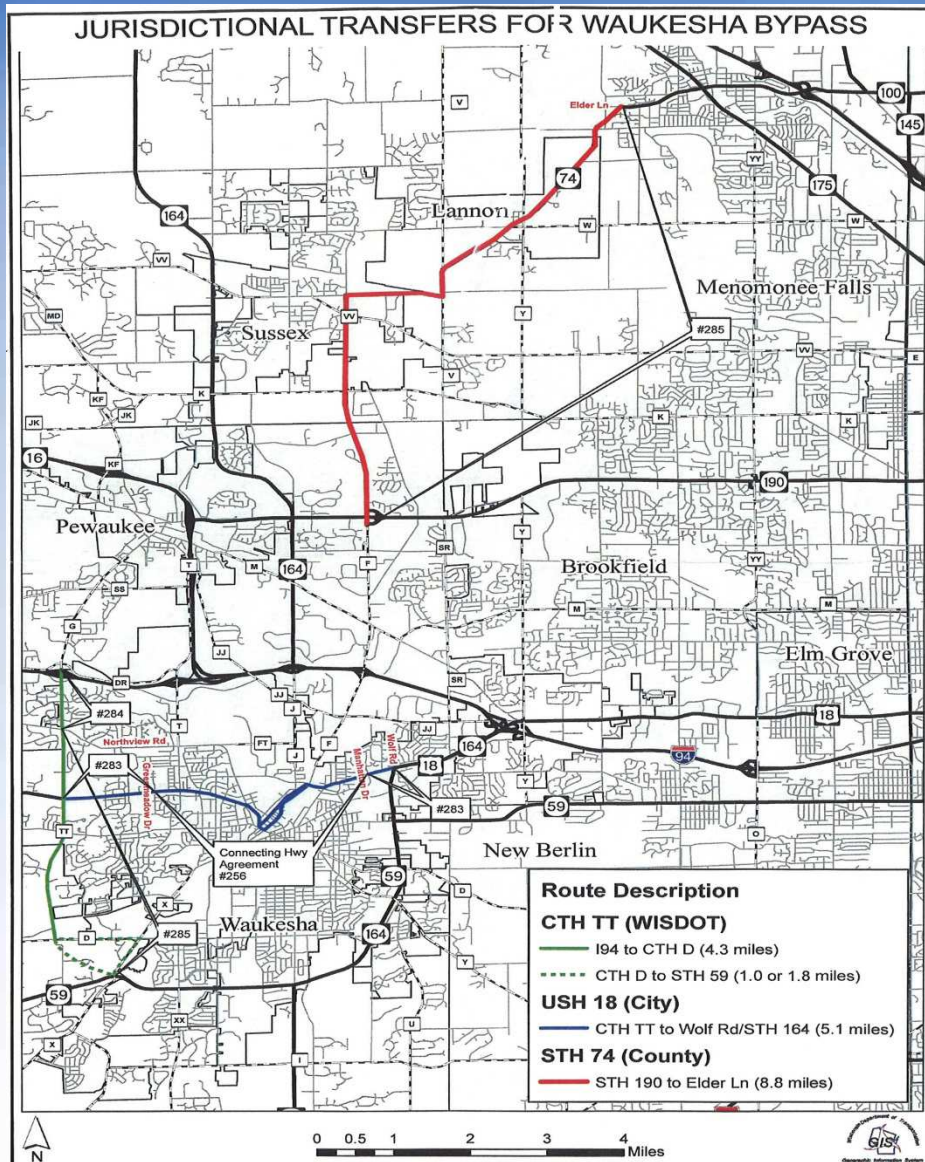

HISTORY

- Fall 2007 – Request from downtown business owners to restrict truck traffic through the downtown.
- Spring 2008 – WDOT performed a Study of trucking through the downtown.
- Fall 2008 – WDOT approached Village about taking over jurisdiction of Main St (STH 74).



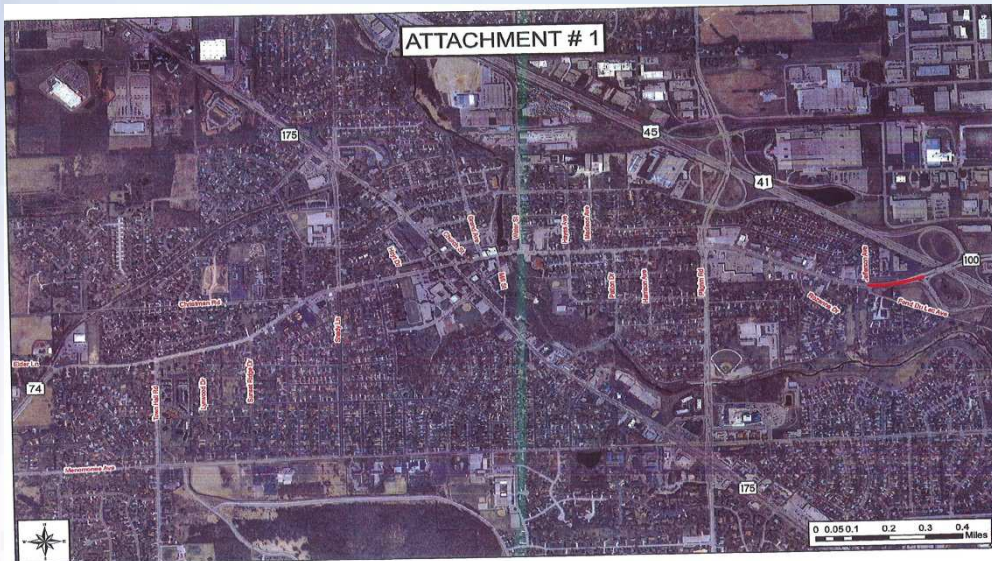
WDOT JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFERS



Waukesha Bypass.

- As part of this project WDOT per their rules they cannot add any new STH miles.
- Therefore WDOT has been looking to offset the new bypass miles by transferring a STH to Local Units of Government.
- Waukesha County would take over STH 74 from Capital Drive to Elder Lane (to be extension of CTH F).
- Village would take over STH 74 from Elder Lane to USH 41/45 SB Ramps.

MAIN ST (STH 74) TRANSFER WDOT to VILLAGE



Village Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement

- Become Local Road under Local control
- Village Responsible for all maintenance.
- Future Reconstruction Projects would be eligible for STP-Urban Program (80%/20% Split)
- WDOT would pay Village \$525,000 to bring roadway up to current standards.
- Agreements approved by Village Board on May 2, 2011.
- Transfer would take place upon final approval of the Waukesha Bypass project by FHWA.
- Transfer will take place on November 1, 2015.
